




Soon, we will go to the library. A library is a place with a lot of books. Many people go to the library.










Rules to Remember:

- The responsibility for a child's health, safety and behavior at the Library resides with the parent or guardian. This policy applies to <u>ALL</u> ages.
- <u>ANY</u> child visiting the Library below <u>6th</u> grade MUST be accompanied by a responsible adult (16 years or older.)
- Children under the age of <u>7 MUST</u> be accompanied and directly supervised at <u>ALL</u> times by a responsible adult (16 years or older.)
- All children visiting the Library are expected to display only appropriate behavior.
 Persistent, inappropriate behavior is grounds for suspension of library privileges.
 Disorderly conduct, fighting, harassment, or <u>ANY</u> illegal activity will result in immediate suspension.
- <u>ALL</u> children must be picked up by the Library's closing time. If a child is not picked up by closing time, the Homewood Police will be notified. 
